With the support of **381** volunteers, we raised over **\$135,000** to create a equitable, inclusive and gender-equal world - while providing permanent housing solutions for **17** people.

With the help of community partners, we completed **17** critical home repair projects for **28** local veterans and their families - like George, who now has a brand new roof.



Pride Build

Together with community partners, **15** LGBTQ+ and ally homeowners were able to receive the minor and critical home repairs they needed to maintain fair and equitable housing.

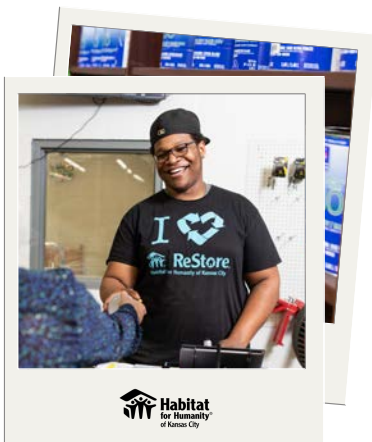
